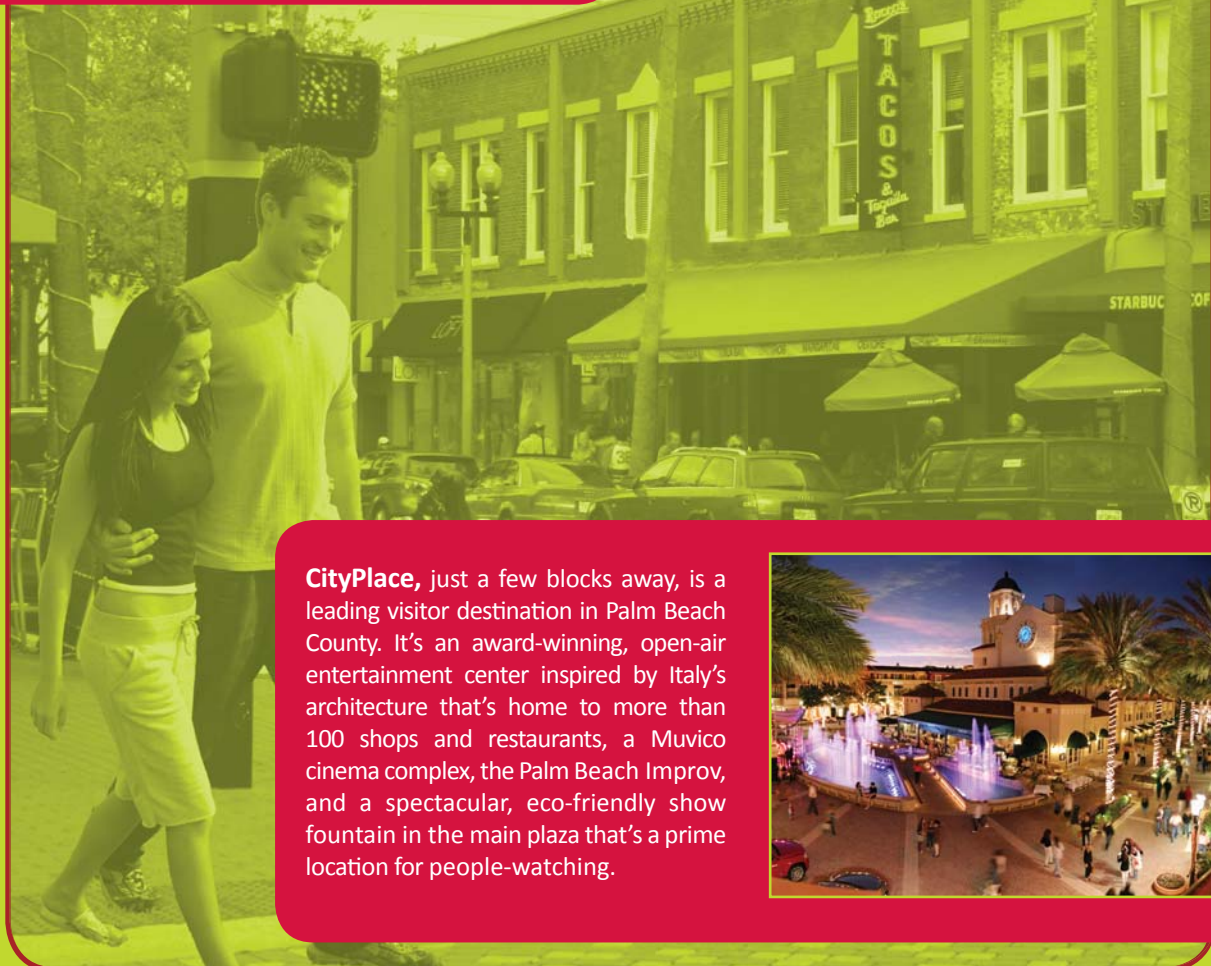

**CityPlace**, just a few blocks away, is a leading visitor destination in Palm Beach County. It's an award-winning, open-air entertainment center inspired by Italy's architecture that's home to more than 100 shops and restaurants, a Muvico cinema complex, the Palm Beach Improv, and a spectacular, eco-friendly show fountain in the main plaza that's a prime location for people-watching.

**MANY PLACES, MANY SPACES**

If you're visiting by car, motorcycle or bike, there are plenty of convenient parking spaces – 8,000 of them, in fact!

- No cash on hand? No problem! The City of West Palm Beach is one of the first in the nation to offer prepay cell phone parking at City lots and meters. Call (561) 283-1039 to register your credit card to pay by cell phone. The first time you use the service, it's free.
- Park in all city lots and garages for two hours for just \$1. Parking is just \$1 for each additional hour.
- City meters are free weekdays after 7pm, Sundays and on holidays.

**TAKE THE SCENIC ROUTE**

Hop on board Downtown's bright red trolley for a free, green-friendly, convenient way to get around to your favorite shops, restaurants, attractions and the waterfront. The trolley travels between Clematis Street and CityPlace.

- **Sunday – Wednesday: 11 am – 9 pm**
- **Thursday – Saturday: 11 am – 11 pm**

Trolley stops are easy to spot and are located on each block of Clematis Street between Rosemary Avenue and Narcissus Avenue, with additional stops Downtown including in front of Macy's at CityPlace and the Kravis Center for the Performing Arts.

**INSIDERS TIP:** This brand new garage is conveniently located to both the Clematis District and CityPlace. It's environmentally friendly with energy efficient lighting and easy payment systems. Pay here with a credit card, and keep in mind the spaces designated for bikes and motorcycles.
